who

All MSU faculty are eligible to join a faculty writing group. Each group is comprised of 3 to 5 members and a facilitator from the writing center.

what

Meetings are conducted in accordance with the needs and preferences of group members; facilitators help by asking questions about writing and writing processes and bringing in new perspectives, as do writing group members.

when

The groups meet once a week for 2 hours and are expected to review the writing of other group members independently for 1 hour each week. The groups meet for at least a semester and up to 1 full year. The meetings are scheduled for the same day each week according to group availability.

where

The groups can meet anywhere they would like. Many groups meet in academic buildings on campus or at the Writing Center. Some meet at more social places, such as local coffee shops.

why

The primary purpose of the groups is to help individuals talk about writing with one another in mutually beneficial ways.

how
